

## ABIM Maintenance of Certification (MOC) Points

To claim up to 27.5 ABIM Maintenance of Certification (MOC) Points for AGS22 In-Person in Orlando and up to 19.5 MOC points for AGS22 On-Demand, you must complete the two-step process outlined below. Please note that the in-person meeting and the on-demand meeting are considered to be 2 separate CME activities (live meeting vs. an internet enduring material), so you must complete **2 separate surveys** for MOC credit if you completed **both** activities.

1. Apply for CME via the online CME site.

2. Answer MOC questions in the appropriate survey(s)
